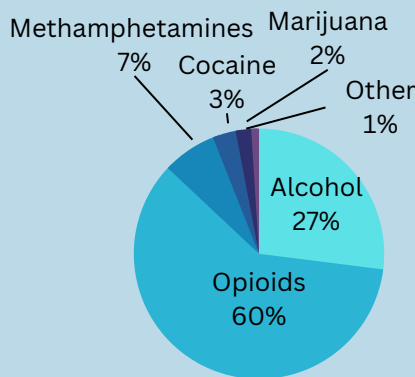

Primary Substance Abuse Drug

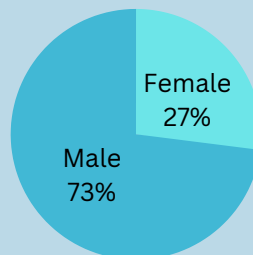

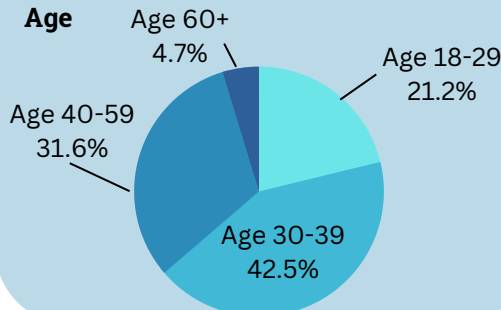
76% of clients fall below federal poverty level.
